KINSTAR forced the pace, dueled on the far turn, vied through the stretch and fought gamely for the win. BEAR ALWAYS was in touch and moved up on the far turn but with a slim lead through the stretch failed to hold. BULLONTHEWIRE had no speed, was roused from the inside on the far turn and closed willingly through the stretch from the outside. KWIK COSTA was in range, a factor from the three path on the far turn and vied from the four path at the top of the stretch but faded late. EXCALIBUR set a pressured pace and dueled on the far turn but gave way through the stretch. KENNISIS RIVER was up close and raced evenly from the inside on the far turn but leveled off. VENABLO reared at the start and showed little in a dull effort. A DEVILISH RIDE was off slowly, showed nothing and was not a factor.
