JUMPSTART LADY was in range, closed the gap on the far turn, a factor from the four path at the top of he stretch and drew clear late. LOVE BRACELET stalked the leader and had a good position on the far turn but was outfinished. BEAUTY PLUS set the pace and had a clear lead on the far turn but weakened in mid stretch. AYENDA was off the pace and hustled along from the three path on the far turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch had no kick. DIVA IN EGBERT was in mid pack and roused on the far turn but from the five path through the stretch lacked a rally. FEAR THE REDHEAD was unhurried early, saved ground on the far turn and passed tired foes through the stretch. HALI'S SWAN was in touch but chased on the far turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch flattened out. PERFECT SUSPECT was well back, showed nothing and was never a threat. STAR DISCOVERY showed no speed, trailed on the far turn and was outdistanced.
