Footnotes

PURE REY (ARG) showed speed between foes, had the lead on the turn, five path at the top of the stretch and was all out. WONDEROUS GLORY was up close, chased from the inside on the turn and held well for place. DEMI SONG was off the pace, gained ground on the turn, eight path at the top of the stretch and rallied outside. COLOSSEUM was in mid field, roused between foes on the turn, had a mild bid in the stretch in a good effort. VEGAS ANGEL was unhurried early, had a mild gain while in hand on the turn and needed more. EL GRAN MARCO stalked the leaders, raced evenly from the inside on the turn and lacked a needed rally. BREAK EVEN trailed the field, showed little and passed tired foes. VERY CLEVER BEAU showed speed from between foes, lost ground on the turn, seven path at the top of the stretch and was no factor. GENERAL JAKE was in mid pack, raced evenly from the four path on the turn, nine path at the top of the stretch and faded. SUGAR N TABACCO had speed outside, was a factor from the four path on the turn, six path at the top of the stretch but tired. BOMARC was off the pace, lost ground on the turn from the six path and was pulled up in the stretch.
