HIDDEN CURVES pressed the pace and kept the heat on the front runner in the far turn, bid and vied with outside rival into the stretch then cleared and proved best. CHERRY GOLD on the outside and 3-wide on the first turn, kept close, bid on the far turn and vied with the winner into early stretch then failed to match but ran on willingly to save the place. XTRA DASH well back and trailing the field in the early going, made up ground turning for home, went wide then finished fast but late. ASHLEY never far back, stalked the leaders and kept contact into the stretch then lacked a final push. MARDEN HILL was on the inside and in mid pack, then lacked the needed rally. STEEVLYN had early speed and slim lead, held it into the far turn, was pressured and faded. FLAMING NORA raced in mid pack and had no bid. NAFEESA was on the inside of foes and in striking distance after going a half but had no rally. MISS FLORIELO had a dull effort and was never in it. RUBY WREN showed little and was never a factor.
