(Races with claiming prices of \$7,500 or less not considered for allowances). The field will be limited to 12 starters. If more than 12 entries pass the entry box, preference will be given to the highest earnings in 2008-2009. Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. (Colts & Geldings Preferred) This is a non Black Type race. BREAK EVEN settled off the pace with work to do, was still back going into the far turn, moved to the six path for the stretch run then came home with a strong wide rally to arrive in time. GREAT ADDICTION kept in touch with an inside trip the bid from there turning for home, led briefly only to be outgunned late. SMILING JORDAN off the pace, gained ground on the far turn and split foes in early stretch then finished willingly. COLD WAR tracked the leader then bid between foes on the far turn and was outfinished in the run to the wire. JUDITHS WILD RUSH came on into the far turn and bid three wide to challenge for the lead after going six then evened out in a five path drive. FREZACON had speed to lead the way, was pressured while off the rail on the far turn then faltered. HENNESY MOON trailed and never did menace. BELFAST DANCER showed little in an off the pace run.
