Footnotes

GRAEME WAFER trailed the field, circled foes on the far turn, four path at the top of the stretch and was much the best. DEPUTY LOR had no speed, was roused from the four path on the far turn and closed belatedly in deep stretch. EXCALIBUR was in range, a factor from the three path on the far turn and needed more in the drive. SLICE OF GLORY was away alertly, set the pace, had a clear lead on the far turn and weakened. ABERCROMBIEANDFISH was in touch, moved up on the backstretch, had a good position at the top of the stretch but tired. MIGHTY SILVER stalked leader, lost ground on the far turn and lacked a rally. RED LAKE GOLD was off the pace, showed little and was never a threat. SEVENTEEN RED was unhurried early, failed to fire in a dull effort.
