Footnotes

NABETHIAN in striking distance, closed 3-wide on the turn for home, bid in the 6-path, rallied and then just held off late outside rival. NUNZIATA outside of foes, was 4-wide and getting into gear entering the stretch, rallied strong in the 7-path and just missed. SMART PURSUIT off the pace, gained from off the rail on the turn, angled in for the drive and finished well inside. DECADENT DASH had speed to lead into the stretch turn then gave way in the drive. MISS FRENCHIE had speed to chase the pacesetter, kept close, bid and gained command on the turn for home, opened a gap then failed to last. CASE OF PRIDE in striking distance from mid pack, lacked the needed rally. RICHLY INFLATED saved ground from mid pack then needed a bid. LIGHT THE PATH off the pace was not a factor. CLEARED TO GO was up close into the turn then backed off and faded. SHAFEERA broke in a tangle and trailed.
