Footnotes

TOASTING MIA was unhurried early, had the lead on the far turn and shook clear through the stretch while kept to task. KIOTARI BAY showed no speed and had a mild gain from the three path on the far turn but from the five path through the stretch was second best. POLITICAL PROMISE was off the pace and closed the gap on the far turn but from the six path through the stretch needed more. RIVER CARD was in mid field and saved ground on the far turn but lacked a serious bid. RIVAS RUN was in mid pack and roused from the three path on the far turn but from the four path through the stretch was no real threat. AGAIN PLEASE showed speed and was roused from between foes on the far turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch faded. FREEDOMBID was in touch and a factor from the inside on the far turn but flattened out in the drive. BULLET BOY was hustled early but chased on the far turn and came up empty.
