Footnotes

HISAKI was in mid pack, roused from the inside on the turn and with a bid from the four path at the top of the stretch drew clear. EUROVALENTINO showed speed and was a factor from the three path on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch was second best. MECKE B KING was well back, closed the gap on the turn and finished well in deep stretch. BOW BELL REEF was off slow and hustled early, led on the turn but gave way through the stretch. ALMOSTOUTOFTHEBLUE was in mid pack and raced evenly on the turn but from the five path through the stretch leveled off. GRAEME WAFER tracked the early leaders and was hustled along on the turn but lacked a late response. BUDDHA N' SMART was unhurried early and chased from the three path on the turn but had no response. CLASSIC MORGEY had no speed and showed nothing while outrun.
