TEJABO'S GIRL rated close up and outside foes, was three wide and bidding on the far turn, kept the rally going under good handling and was just up in time. SEE U AT MY WINDOW had early speed to show the way, held sway almost every step of the way only to be caught in the final jump. IS SHE REAL off the pace but in touch, went outside and was 4-wide on the far turn, swerved in under pressure in early stretch then ran on with good energy. COLEBROOKADVANTAGE pressed the early pace then tracked the leader from the inside, bid up the rail but lacked a final push. GOLDEN COMMODITY kept close and bid on the far turn to loom a factor then hung in the drive. ARMISTICE DAY had an off the pace trip and backed away in the final half-mile.
