SOUTHERN VALENTINE was off the pace, had a mild gain on the far turn, a factor in mid stretch and drew clear. EMILY CARR was in range, had a good position on the far turn and vied from the six path through the stretch but was no match for the winner. SEEKING FORTUNE was in mid pack and a factor from the three path on the far turn but from the five path through the stretch finished evenly. SOUTH BEACH ANNA was wide on the first turn, set the pace and dueled from between foes on the far turn but from the four path through the stretch was all out. I'LL BE HOME SOON was well back, closed the gap on the far turn but was not a factor. RAHFEES FAIRY showed speed from the inside and had the lead into the far turn but weakened in mid stretch. PERFECT SUSPECT had no speed and showed little while never in contention. SILENT SMILE was in touch and roused from the inside on the far turn but came up empty.
