WIND SPEAKER was up close, forced the pace on the far turn, had a bid through the stretch and fought gamely for the win. MY OUT KAST showed speed and set the pace, had mild pressure on the far turn and vied through the stretch but just missed. FLOWER GIRL had no speed and was a factor from the three path on the far turn but finished evenly. WHAT SAY YOU tracked the leader and was roused from the inside on the far turn but lacked a late response. SILVER FEELING was unhurried early, trailed the field on the far turn and passed tired foes. USHANKA was in range but chased from the three path on the far turn and from the four path through the stretch had no impact. ADMIT was off the pace, had a mild gain from the four path on the far turn but from the six path through the stretch leveled off. SILVER MINIKIN was in touch but lost ground on the far turn and from the five path through the stretch was empty.
