REGAL DIAMOND was away alertly, set the pace, had a clear lead on the turn and was kept to task in the stretch. GRAIN OF TRUTH stalked the leader, was a factor on the turn, had a striking position through the stretch but was second best. BELLA CREEK was off the pace, raced evenly from the three path on the turn, six path at the top of the stretch and closed willingly. BLACK NAPKINS was kept close, chased from the inside on the turn, had a bid in upper stretch but needed more. PEACE N THE VALLEY was in mid pack, roused from the three path on the turn, five path at the top of the stretch and evened out in the drive. ROCK A TONG trailed the field, had a mild gain from the inside on the turn but failed to fire in the stretch. FASTER THAN A JET showed no speed, was hustled between foes on the turn and was no factor.
