### Footnotes

ANGEL IN LACE was well back early, moved up from the four path on the far turn, six path at the top of the stretch and was going away. SKIP THE NIGHT was unhurried early, closed the gap from the three path on the far turn, five path at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner. BYE BYE FOR NOW was away alertly, had a clear lead on the far turn and gave way late in the stretch. DANCINGTHENITEAWAY was back early, gained ground from the three path on the far turn and leveled off. RAGING THIRST trailed the field, was hustled along on the far turn and finished well in the stretch. BEAR WHITE SOCKS was in range, raced evenly from the inside on the far turn and tired in upper stretch. SOCIALLY ACTIVE was in touch, raced between foes on the far turn and flattened out. DOMESTIC DILIGENCE stalked the leader, lost ground on the far turn in a dull effort. MY CASH BOX was up close early, backed away into the far turn and was empty.
