### Footnotes

EXPLOSIVE GREEK was away alertly, set the pace, took command on the turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch was kept to task. CLASSIC MORGEY was in mid pack, hustled on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch was up for place. ICANONLYIMAGINEIT stalked the leader and was roused from the inside on the turn but needed more through the stretch. BANYAN COURT was in range and had a good position on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch evened out. MONTROSE AVENUE was in touch and a factor from between foes on the turn but lacked a late response. BUCK CASH was off the pace and raced from the five path on the turn but from the seven path at the top of the stretch had a dull effort. BUDDHA N' SMART was back early and raced from the six path on the turn but from the eight path through the stretch had no impact. LIBIAMO was unhurried early and hustled hard on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch had no response. ARMORED showed no speed and chased from the three path on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch was not a factor.
