WONDEROUS GLORY had an inside trip while tracking the leader, bid inside that one and proved best under good handling. LIVE QUOTE came from off the pace and the inside to put in a late run and finish well between foes. CALEDON CAT led the way and was in charge through the turn but gave way to the top two in an off the rail drive. CHARMING KISSES in mid pack and in the three path into the stretch, put in a mild try. BILBO tracked the leader after breaking smartly, was up on the pace through the turn then evened out. CUSACK in striking distance and three wide on the turn, had no stretch kick. AVOID THE RUSH trailed and was never a factor. TOOTAINTEED stumbled and bumped at the break, never did menace.
