### Footnotes

DEPUTY LOR was back early, closed the gap on the far turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch proved to be much the best. VENABLO was well back, gained ground on the far turn and from the four path through the stretch was up for place. EXCALIBUR stalked the leader and had a clear lead into the far turn but from the three path through the stretch was tired. JAZZ BOY was in range and had a good position on the far turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch had no kick. SHOOT FOR A CURE showed no speed, moved up from the three path on the far turn but from the five path through the stretch needed more. CLASSIC RUCKIS was in mid pack and roused on the far turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch failed to fire. PATATI PATATA was off the pace, trailed the field on the far turn and was not a factor. KENNISIS RIVER showed speed but dropped back on the far turn and was outdistanced.
