Footnotes

AFRICAN RAINBOW trailed the field to the top of the stretch and rallied from the five path through the lane to get up in time. SNOW RITE set the pace, was pressured on the turn, had the lead in deep stretch but failed to hold. JUMPTOCONCLUSIONS was unhurried early, gained ground from the three path on the turn in a good effort. SOUTHERN FLAME stalked the leader, chased on the turn and had a bid through the stretch but was outfinished. STORMY SHAY was in touch, hustled from the inside on the turn but lacked a late response. ONE FOXY MAMA had no speed, showed little and was never a threat. WIGGLE AND A WINK was in mid pack, raced evenly between foes on the turn and flattened out in the stretch.
