JOHN G C was unhurried early, had a mild gain on the far turn vied from the four path at the top of the stretch but evened out. VENABLO was in mid pack, chased the leaders on the far turn, three path at the top of the stretch but was not enough. DEPUTY LOR was in touch, lacked room on the far turn from the inside and passed tired foes in the stretch. KISSEROO stalked the leader early, had a slim lead on the far turn but gave way in the stretch. FLAGRANTE DELICTO was away alertly, set the pace, dropped back on the backstretch and was outdistanced.
