JEALOUS LOVER stalked the speed duel then bid 3-wide on the far turn, took a slim lead into the final furlong then was full out to stave off late challenge. FAXXY SAL came from off the pace and closed ground outside off foes on the far turn, then bid in the 6-path through the stretch and finished fast but late. ESSIE D'OR stalked the pace duel then bid between on the far turn and rallied up the rail in a good effort. VASKRISSENYA had a belated off the rail run in the drive after and inside trip. FRIENDLY SLEW had a mild stumble at the break, showed speed to take a slim lead, dueled outside of rival, shook off that one, then gave way in the drive. ARMISTICE DAY in striking distance early and off the rail, failed to rally. BUBBLY BROOKE pressed inside then dueled into the far turn before fading.
