HENNESY MOON came from mid pack to close 3-wide on the far turn, was five wide into the stretch then rallied strong to prevail clear. TOBAR dueled outside of foe, took on other rivals on the far turn, kept at it and ran on to the wire to be best of the rest. YES IT'S BULL unhurried in the early going, gained ground, was wide for the stretch try and finished willingly. RIGHTLY ROYAL gained ground from the inside and bid from there in the drive only to be outfinished. THUNDER FOX off a step slow, stalked the pace and was between foes and in the game into the stretch then needed a late kick. DASHING MONTY was off the pace from mid pack and did not menace. INTERTWINED had an early duel and battled with rival for six then took on others and faltered inside. ROAD NOT TRAVELED was off as step slow, trailed and was never close. TOTHEMOONANDBACK stalked the bid 3-wide on the far turn only to fade from the scene in the drive.
