CAT N SASSY off the pace then six wide on the stretch turn, rallied strong to just nip inside rivals. JUDITH'S AIDAN had good speed to press the inside pace, dueled on the turn, led late then missed. DOUBLE NAUGHT SPY came on strong through the turn, bid from the three path, finished well between foes and caught the show. MALIBU MONSTER came from well back to fire down the lane while widest and was going well late. FLASHY J R vied for the lead and dueled to mid stretch then gave way. BEAU BRETT was hung out wide throughout then evened out. RUBATO D'ORO was off the pace and not a factor. CASSIENUS did not threaten with a wide finish. JERRY'S CONNECTION lacked a bid and did not menace. SEAFIELDS tracked the leaders on the turn then tired. BARRICHELLO had brief speed between foes, backed off and never threatened. I BOOGIE was on the pace before fading while inside on the turn.
