SAM'S BAY stumbled at the start, vied on the turn and with the lead from the three path at the top of the stretch proved best. PRINCE OF ASCOT was in touch, raced evenly on the turn and closed from the inside through the stretch to get up for place. CHASING BRIDGET was in range, hustled along from the three path on the turn and from the four path through the stretch closed willingly. COME OUT AHEAD was away alertly and set a pressured pace but faded through the stretch. BEARS NORTHERN forced the pace but chased on the turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch was empty. DAVE AND KATE was hustled early and saved ground on the turn but had no impact. HOT IN ANY WAY had no speed, was a factor from the four path through the stretch but ducked out and lost his rider. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN LEFT THE RESULTS AS POSTED.
