ANOTHER KITTEN was in touch, had a mild gain on the turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch proved best. MAKAR stalked the leaders and raced evenly on the turn but was in tight through the stretch in a good effort. ZENKO was in mid pack, roused from the inside on the turn and finished well. IT'SAPOSSIBILITY showed speed and had a slim lead on the turn but gave way late. CELERITY'S SUMMIT had no speed and saved ground on the turn but had no impact. DOPPLER RADAR was hustled early and dueled from the inside on the turn but came up empty. ONE MORE DAY was well back and showed nothing while never dangerous.
