### Footnotes

AEOLUS gained ground from off the rail, caught the front runner at the furlong pole, took charge then drew clear. PENTHOUSE VIEW vied early and then led into the far turn, was challenged in the stretch and gave way inside but held the place spot. ITSWHATWELIVEFORE never far back, tracked the leader into the far turn then came up with a mild stretch bid but needed more. COOK'S LOOK off the pace, came up with a belated stretch run while off the rail but did not threaten the top three. JON SNOW unhurried early, was never close and not a factor in the drive. KWIK COSTA raced well back and trailed into the stretch before passing a tired one. DUGALD had brief inside speed, backed off then gradually faded through the stretch and trailed the field home.
