**Footnotes**

IT'SAPOSSIBILITY showed speed, set the pace, had the lead on the turn and widened under light handling through the stretch. CAT N SASSY showed no speed, had a mild gain on the turn and rallied through the stretch to get up for place. DESTIND TO PAY was squeezed back at the start, moved up from the three path on the turn and from the seven path through the stretch was all out. ROYAL EXPLOSIVE was in mid pack and hustled along from the three path on the turn but from the five path through the stretch had no kick. ROLAND'S SWORD was in touch and saved ground on the turn but failed to fire. LET'S GO BEAR tracked the early leader and raced evenly on the turn but from the four path through the stretch was empty.
