WHATYADO was kept close, roused from the three path on the turn, had a bid from the four path at the top of the stretch and was all out. MADAME ALI set the pace, had a clear lead on the turn, was pressured at the top of the stretch and outgunned. MYAH'S GRACE stalked the leaders, was a factor from the inside on the turn and needed more in the drive. MAYBE I CAN was unhurried early, gained ground from the inside on the turn and finished evenly. WHO'S THAT ONE was in touch, chased from between foes on the turn and lacked a closing bid in the stretch. JIGGY JIGGY was well back, saved ground on the turn and was never in contention. MY MOUSE HUNT was off slowly, raced evenly from the three path on the turn, six path at the top of the stretch and was outrun. ONE SPARK was in touch early, dropped back into the turn and was pulled up at the top of the stretch.
