BANYAN COURT was in touch, a factor from the inside on the turn, vied through the stretch and proved best. KING NAIVE set the pace, had a clear lead on the turn, was pressured through the stretch and second best. YOU WOOD was in mid field, had a striking position from the three path at the top of the stretch but was outfinished. LONE SPRINT was off the pace, hustled from the three path on the turn and had a mild rally through the stretch. DREAM HOLIDAY was in range, chased on the turn, five path at the top of the stretch and needed more in the drive. ROAD TO MT ZIONHI stalked the leader, backed away on the turn, five path at the top of the stretch and was outrun. MAN OF STEEL was unhurried early, gained ground from the five path on the turn, seven path at the top of the stretch and evened out. BREAKING FREE trailed the field, saved ground on the turn but was never a threat.
