ORIGINAL ONE sped to the lead into the first turn, settled off the rail and opened a gap, maintained a clear lead while drifting out slightly on the stretch turn then stayed clear to the wire. CHRIS'S BAD BOY chased the speed from the outset, could not close on the pacesetter and settled for second best. BARBAROSS came from mid field to put in a mild off the rail bid but failed to threaten the top two. LATIN TECHNOLOGY was off a step slow and trailed early, made up ground but did not menace. BIBYE was in mid pack before making a mild inside move on the far turn then failed to menace in the drive. MALCOHA settled off the pace throughout, finished wide and was not a factor. ECHO LANDING had an inside trip to stalk the speed, then tired from the rail.
