CUSACK off the early pace, gained while 3-wide on the turn then angled in while bidding in early stretch and rallied from the rail to prove best. SEA SPICE vied 3-wide in the early going, was in charge turning for home, led into the final furlong then had to settle for second best. ABERCROMBIEANDFISH in mid pack, split foes in the drive and finished off a mild rally. AVOID THE RUSH trailed before coming out widest for the stretch try and then had a late go at it. BUDDHA N' SMART in the game and between foes on the turn lacked a needed rail bid. ETERNAL CHARM in mid pack and then four wide into the stretch, lacked the needed rally. REGALLY RED vied between foes and was a factor through the turn then weakened. GRAY JET hustled inside, backed off on the turn and faded inside.
