CANDLES ON FRIDAY had no speed, moved up from the three path on the far turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch was all out for the win. POLITICAL REBEL was in range, had a mild gain on the far turn and raced from the four path at the top of the stretch but angled inside and finished well. MARIMBA MAN was unhurried early, had a slim lead on the far turn but drifted out through the stretch and gave way late. KIOTARI BAY was in touch and roused from the inside on the far turn but from the six path through the stretch was no real threat. POLITICAL PROMISE was well back, saved ground on the far turn and passed tired foes through the lane. RIVAS RUN was hustled early and set the pace but was headed on the far turn and weakened. JIMMY'S CAMPAIGN was in mid pack and hustled along from the three path on the far turn but from the seven path through the stretch had a dull effort. COUNTY TRICK tracked the leader from the inside but chased on the far turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch came up empty. RIVER CARD was off the pace and showed nothing while not a factor.
