FYNBOS stalked the leaders after breaking smartly, kept close and bid in the 4-path in the stretch run, got to the leader in mid stretch and went clear. ALWAYS SPLIT ACES had speed to duel outside of rival into the turn, led into the stretch then was full out but failed to last. J AND B'S NU IMAGE dueled for the lead from the inside, kept close on the turn then tired in the drive but bested the rest. PERSUE stalked the leaders from the inside the put in a mild 4-path bid. GYPSY ROMANCE was close up on the pace early, backed off and had no second effort. PROSPECTIVE GAL off the pace, was wide into the stretch and did not menace. RUBY TANGO was off the pace throughout and had no rally. NABETHIAN chased the speed from between foes in the early going then faded.
