Footnotes

BETTER BELIEVE was in mid pack, raced evenly from the four path on the turn and from the seven path through the stretch rallied in time. BOW BELL REEF showed speed from the inside, was roused on the turn and had the lead in mid stretch but was outfinished. MR MOJITO (IRE) was in touch, had a forward position on the turn and from the six path through the stretch had a good effort. MO STAR showed no speed, had a mild gain on the turn but was in tight through the stretch while all out. THUNDER ROCK dueled from between foes and vied on the turn but gave way late. FORTIUS was off the pace, raced evenly on the turn and from the six path through the stretch passed tired foes. UNCLE BELLUM was in range and saved ground on the turn but lacked a rally. BLUSHING NOODLE showed speed from the outside and was hustled along from the three path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch faded. GIN JOINT was off the pace and showed little while not a factor. ONE MORE DAY was well back and trailed throughout in a dull effort. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER ON MO STAR AGAINST BOW BELL REEF FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE THROUGH THE STRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED.
