HIGH SOCIETY GIRL dueled inside of rival and battled into the stretch then faltered. MY DEAR ROSE raced in mid field and inside of foes and came up with a mild 3-path try. MISS DEED off the pace, was bidding while 4-wide into the stretch but needed more. RED PENNY had a mild gain after trailing but was not a factor. SNIP CREEK raced off the pace and did not fire. LA LOBO faded after saving ground and being up close. BOLD WISDOM backed away after being in the hunt early. CYNDI'S BEAUTY in touch early, backed off and faded. IMAMYTO was never a factor.
