G BELLA in the hunt and chasing the two leaders, was in the four path for the stretch bid, rallied and arrived just in time. NOT A COALITION in mid field and then in the five path into the stretch, angled to the rail then caught fire and came home fast but missed. PRECIOUS CARGO led the way into the turn, held sway into the stretch from off the rail, looked home free but was caught in the final strides. YIKES AT LAST in mid pack, had a late inside run to no avail. SHE'S SO SAUCY raced off the pace, showed little and was never a factor. ELYSIUM GATE stumbled at the break, trailed into the stretch and was never a threat. CANAL DAZE hit the gate and the rail at the break, rushed inside to track the leader then had nothing to give in the run to the wire. MOBIL DANCER raced off the pace throughout and came up empty.
