SWEEPING FRONT stalked the pace while close up and outside, bid and took command on the stretch turn then went clear and proved much the best. LUCKY IMAGE vied inside of rivals from the get-go, kept in the hunt and chased the winner home in a game effort for the place spot. MARIANNA was trailing the field into the stretch then finished off the trip with a belated off the rail try. ESSA'S LOVE had good speed to vie outside rival, was between foes on the turn then evened out in the run to the wire. CROATIAN DIVA in mid pack, failed to threaten and lacked the needed stretch rally. TAKTIME saved ground and had no impact in the stretch run. GLENCREE stalked the pacesetters in a good early trip then had nothing to offer when the serious running began.
