**Footnotes**

HIGH PLATEAU showed speed, dueled from the inside on the far turn, shook clear in deep stretch and prevailed. CLEVER KING was off the pace, moved up on the far turn and from the five path through the stretch finished well. ALPHABET KID was in range and raced evenly on the far turn but from the four path through the stretch lacked a late kick. IMITATION OF LIFE had no speed and was roused from the three path on the far turn but lacked a serious bid. EXCALIBUR forced the pace and had a slim lead on the far turn but gave way in mid stretch. COOL DIABLO was well back and had a mild gain on the far turn but from the five path through the stretch had no impact. SOMARVELOUS was in touch early but lost ground on the far turn and from the four path through the stretch was empty.
