WHISPERED LEGEND was hustled early, had the lead on the turn and took command from the four path at the top of the stretch to prove best. BURNING MANDATE lunged at the start, closed the gap on the turn and rallied on the rail through the stretch. GRANT'S LOVE stalked the early leader and was hustled on the turn but from the eight path through the stretch finished evenly. YANKEE BAILEY WEST was in touch, roused from the inside on the turn and was a factor at the top of the stretch but faded late. ACED THE MOVES was in range and saved ground on the turn but lacked a late response. BUBBLE WRAPPED was unhurried early and showed little while not a factor. DOCTOR JACK stumbled at the start and lost his rider. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START LEFT THE RESULTS AS POSTED.
