Footnotes

SOUTHERN FLAME forced the pace, had the lead on the far turn, took command through the stretch and proved best. WHOS HOT NOW was in mid pack and gained ground from the inside on the far turn but from the four path through the stretch was second best. SKIP THE NIGHT set a pressured pace and was hustled on the far turn but needed more. DIVINE DESTINY had no speed, raced evenly from the inside on the far turn and had a mild gain through the stretch. WHATYADO broke outward and moved up from the four path on the far turn but from the five path through the stretch was tired. VOODOO MOMMA broke awkwardly, stalked the leaders and was a factor from the three path on the far turn but was empty through the stretch. GENTLE was unhurried early, trailed the field on the far turn and was never a threat.
