MR. HENRY TWO U stalked the leader, was a factor on the turn and with the lead from the four path at the top of the stretch was kept to task. ME THE SEA AND G T was back early, moved up from the inside on the turn, had a bid through the the stretch and fought gamely in defeat. KWIK COSTA was off slow, roused from the three path on the turn and from the five path through the stretch had a good effort. DISBELIEF was well back, trailed the field on the turn and from the five path through the stretch had a belated rally. ALPHABET KID was unhurried and saved ground on the turn but lacked a late response. BUCK CASH was off the pace and raced evenly on the turn but from the four path through the stretch lacked a rally. PHILLY FRENZY set the pace and had a clear lead into the turn but tired in mid stretch. BANYAN COURT was in range and had a good position between foes on the turn but from the three path through the stretch was empty late.
