Footnotes

STARZANNE rated early, launched her rally three-wide on the far turn, drifted out slightly at the top of the stretch, gained the lead midstretch and came in under left-handed urging in deep stretch. SEARCH THE STORM, well back early, closed along the rail through the far turn, moved out between foes at the eighth pole to tender her bid, lost her path in deep stretch and was checked. SOUTHERN SONG set a reserved pace, was joined on the far turn, dueled to the stretch, wore down PARDON R CRICKET in deep stretch but had already been passed by the first two finishers. PARDON R CRICKET stalked the pace, challenged entering the far turn, dueled to deep stretch and gave way. GREYORGRAY saved ground, was roused on the far turn but finished evenly. BEAUTIFUL DAY stalked the pace, closed up briefly late backstretch then flattened out. YOU'RE SWEET raced evenly, was three-wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. DIANE'S STAR was through early. RUNFORURLIFE broke in the air and was outrun.
