TREE LO kept close then bid inside on the turn to vie with the early leader, broke clear of that one and then was never threatened in the final furlong. STORMY SHAY settled off the pace, bid from the five path in the stretch run and got up to catch the place spot. UPMARKET GIRL well back in the early going, trailed on the turn then swung wide for the drive and was going well late while outside of foes. UP AGAINST IT in mid pack, got it going in the drive but the mild bid was not enough while finishing inside of foes. BLACK NAPKINS had early speed, vied early and then dueled into the stretch before giving way. GRAIN OF TRUTH was on the pace while outside of foes then had no stretch kick. SINGA SONGFOR SLEW backed off after showing speed into the turn then faded.
