Footnotes

HEREISTHERING had outside speed to be three wide and going for the lead into the turn, cleared rivals and opened a gap then was never threatened in an off the rail drive. SHOPPING QUEEN had speed between foes, was steadied into the turn, chased the leader from the 5-path into the stretch then settled for second best. BID FROM THE BAR had inside speed to vie for the lead, tracked from off the rail on the turn then ran on to save the show spot. COLEEZPEENUTT in mid pack and well off the pace, had a late off rail run but it was not enough. DOC'S ENDEAVOR tracked from the inside then finished inside without menacing. SWAMP PATROL well back early, failed to menace with a mild late move and was not a factor. STAR OF JADE was off the pace throughout. STRAWBERRYFLATCAKE lost ground from mid pack and trailed the field home. The rider of SHOPPING QUEEN lodged a claim of foul against the winner for alleged interference going into the turn. After a STEWARDS' review there was no change in the order of finish and the claim of foul was disallowed.
