Footnotes

REVELARE was in touch, had a good inside position on the far turn, angled out to the five path through the stretch and was up in time. BORN TO BOOGIE stumbled at the start, moved up from the four path on the far turn and had the lead in mid stretch while all out. SECOND CUP set a pressured pace, had a slim lead from the inside on the far turn and vied through the stretch but was outfinished. COUNTY TRICK was up close and a factor from the three path on the far turn but flattened out late. BORREGO ROAD was unhurried early and roused from the three path on the far turn but from the six path through the stretch had no kick. CAVALIERDANCER forced the pace and had a bid from between foes on the far turn but tired in mid stretch.
