HIGH PLATEAU stalked the leader, was a factor on the far turn and widened under light handling through the stretch. WILDCAT PRINCE was unhurried early, closed the gap on the far turn and from the five path through the stretch rallied. SQUEEZE THE FOX was in touch, raced evenly on the far turn and from the four path through the stretch was up for show. EXCALIBUR was off slow, saved ground on the far turn but from the five path through the stretch needed more. RENT A FRIEND set the pace but was headed on the far turn and was tired in mid stretch. HISAKI was in range and had a good inside position on the far turn but from the three path through the stretch faded late. BOULDER SPRINGS had no speed, trailed the field throughout and was outdistanced.
