DEPUTY LOR was in mid pack, hustled from the three path on the far turn, four path at the top of the stretch and evened out. SLICE OF GLORY was in touch, lost ground on the far turn and had no impact. WHISKEY SPECIAL trailed the field, showed nothing and was never in contention. LIQUID AMBER was off the pace, roused from the inside on the far turn and was empty.
