Footnotes

NEW YORK HOLIDAY set a reserved pace, took command at the top of the stretch and was much the best. NATURAL TALENT was in range, roused from the inside on the far turn and held well for place. PLAYA NEGRA stalked the leader and was a factor on the far turn but chased through the stretch while all out. SIR VIVA trailed the field, saved ground on the far turn and passed tired foes through the stretch. A DEVILISH RIDE was in touch and hustled hard from the three path on the far turn but had no response. SPRING RIDGE had no speed and raced evenly from the four path on the far turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch was outrun.
