NUEVO DINERO showed speed, set a pressured pace, had a clear lead on the turn and was kept to task through the stretch. LERIDA was off slow, gained ground from the three path on the turn and was a factor at the top of the stretch but was second best. AYENDA had no speed, trailed the field on the turn and had a mild gain through the stretch. BEAU JESS settled off the early leaders and was roused from the three path on the turn but had no impact. BEEJAYKAY duelled from the inside early but chased on the turn and tired in mid stretch. SILVER HOOFBELTS broke awkwardly and was rushed up but tired in mid stretch.
