HIGH PLATEAU had speed to lead into the clubhouse turn, held sway then widened with authority and proved much the best. CAT'S NOT HOME four wide in the early going, kept in touch, was inside on the far turn then chased the winner home in a second best effort. SCOOBY DUBAI off the early pace, was in the four path for the stretch run, had a mild bid and was up for the show. MALIBU MONSTER stalked the leaders in a good trip, bid from the 3-path in the driver but did not have enough. LIVING THE LIFE lost the stirrup at the break, gained it and had an inside trip but did not menace. WHITEBETW'NTHEEYES tracked the leader then began to tire on the far turn and faded. EL PATRONE failed to rally and was not a factor. LOUIE BONOMI close early then faded on the far turn and trailed the field home.
