Footnotes

LOCALLY MADE was unhurried early, moved up on the turn and from the four path through the stretch proved best. BEYOND MY CONTROL was in range, a factor on the turn and from the three path through the stretch had a good effort. BE A BULL was back early, had a mild gain on the turn and from the three path through the stretch was the best of the rest. BEST IN EGBERT was off the pace, saved ground on the turn and was up for a share. CAT N SASSY was in touch and raced evenly on the turn but lacked a serious bid. HARDROAD TO HEAVEN showed no speed and was hustled along from the four path on the turn but from the eight path through the stretch had no impact. WHEATYNBERT showed speed from the inside and had a clear lead on the turn but gave way through the stretch. BEAR AND ROD was hustled early but chased on the turn and had nothing left.
